ORDER OF PLAY

Events are *first to enter, last to play*, however all "early bird" entries received by 11:59 pm July 25 will be considered to be randomly received on July 25.

All orders of play will be posted one week before the Games on the BCPA website (www.bcpipers.org) and at 8 am at the Competition Secretary's area on Games day.

Competitors not ready to play in the posted order may be disqualified.

SCHEDULE
